NOTICE

In accordance with the resolutions of the online meeting held between the hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Prof. G. P. Prasain and Deans, COE, HODs, Wardens and Students' representatives on 26th April 2021, it is hereby notified that

1. In view of the sudden upsurge of number of COVID-19 cases and the notification from Higher Education Department, Govt. of Tripura, Tripura University has also postponed all the semester examinations of UG/PG courses to ensure the safety and security of students.
2. No decision as of now shall be taken regarding conduct of the remaining UG/PG semester exams.
3. No decision as of now shall be taken regarding conduct of online RET 2020-21 also.
4. Accordingly, all PG Hostels shall be closed and students of the said hostels are informed to vacate the hostels by 1st week of May 2021.
5. Compulsory daily attendance of fulltime research scholars in the department is hereby suspended till further order. However, research scholars willing to attend the Department on regular basis for their research activities need to take permission from the authority through their respective supervisors.
6. Research scholars from Humanities and Social Sciences are encouraged to leave hostels and pursue their research work from home in online mode.
7. Those scholars staying in hostels and engaged in Laboratory based research activities or having Ph. D submission scheduled in next six months shall be allowed to stay in hostels subject to their submission of written consent from their supervisors and parents. All hostellers must use masks and sanitizers even within the hostel and strictly follow all SOPs issued for Hostellers in accordance with Clause 4.2.3 of UGC Guidelines dated 5th Nov. 2020.
8. International students/scholars staying in hostels shall be allowed to continue in hostels in view of the closure of the International border.
9. In view of increasing Covid cases, hostellers are ordered to restrict their movements between hostel and departments only, and avoid unnecessary loitering. The Warden shall maintain a Register at the hostel gate to monitor the entry and exit of scholars. If complained against, unruly scholars shall not be allowed to stay in hostels.
10. Entry for visitors inside the University Campus is restricted without prior permission.

11. All Officers/Teaching/Non-teaching staff are requested to be vigilant so that all relevant protocols of Covid-19 are followed in respective Departments/Branches/Sections.
