GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL FOR RESEARCH PROJECTS

Introduction:

The Women's Studies Centre, Tripura University is a UGC sponsored Centre under Tripura University, established in 2011 dedicated exclusively to research, advocate and generate discourses on women's issues within the state and beyond. The Women's Study Centre is now empowered to act as a full-fledged research Centre and carry out activities:

1. To generate awareness about the role of women in society,
2. To find out women's own perception of their lives, their struggles and aspirations,
3. To investigate roots and structures of gender inequality, violence against women, domestic and otherwise,
4. To facilitate research about women's issues and conditions with specific reference to the state of Tripura, etc.

The Women's Study Centre, Tripura University is seeking fresh proposals for **two (2) research projects** from teaching faculties and social science scholars interested in pursuing research in the field of Women Studies, to be funded by Women's Study Centre, Tripura University for the 2016-17 financial year.

Nature of Assistance: The total amount of assistance will be of **Rs. 1 lakh** per project.

Tenure of project: The tenure of implementation of the project will be **one year** from the date of sanction of the project proposal.

Procedure for Approval:

The interested candidates are requested to apply to the **Director, Women's Study Centre, Tripura University** in the prescribed proforma along with a Covering letter within **31st January 2017**. The submitted proposals will be screened by a Subject Expert Committee, and a final decision on selection will be taken on the basis of recommendations of the Expert Committee. The project is not transferable. There will be no extension of tenure under any circumstances. If the investigator fails to complete the project within the prescribed period, he/she has to refund the entire amount along with interest to the Centre.

Procedure of Release of Assistance:

The total amount of Rs. 1 Lakh will be released in **2 (two) equal installments**. The 1st installment will be released along with the sanctioning of the project, while the second installment will be released after a completion of 6 (six) months, upon submission of half-yearly Progress Report and adjustment of the Expenditure of the 1st instalment along with supportive documents.
