The State : The beautiful state Tripura is a landlocked and hilly state in North – East India surrounded by the neighboring country Bangladesh on its south, west and north. It shares a 53 km long border with Assam and a 109 km long border with Mizoram. Tripura has tropical climate, but in the month of November the local weather is pleasant with temperature ranging between 16.4°C to 20.4°C.

The University: Tripura University started its journey as UGC recognized Post-graduate Centre of the University of Calcutta at Maharaja Bir Bikram College in the year 1976. In 1987, Tripura University formally came into its existence as a State University. In the year 2007, finally it was converted into a Central University. The University campus is located near about 18 km away from the Agartala Airport and 5 km from Agartala Railway Station towards the south.

The Department: The Department of Education, Tripura University has been established in 2011 and started its M. A program in 2012 with a commitment to prepare students as future Educationist/ Teacher Educators / Researchers for contributing significantly to the development of state and the nation at large.

The Seminar:

Present Century is called the age of LPG i.e. Globalization, Privatization and liberalization. With the progress of industrialization and modernization the people of India have undergone strong change in their life style. People of present century can not confined themselves in one place, or one country. Globalization makes the people global which stimulate them to become the active part of this universe. We are also intending to explore the challenges faced by tribal society due to the pressure of modernization and globalization. Finally we wish to determine the proper direction towards policy framing for strengthening the tribal society within the network of modernization and globalization.
