

The students are the pivotal point of a University system. It is for their overall development and academic training that the university works tirelessly, with the teachers directly interacting with the students; the supporting staff, examination section, and the administration facilitating this process by making the overall journey from admission to passing out smooth and effective for the students. For smooth functioning of the entire system, each segment has to be allowed to work with reasonable comfort with an idea about the assessment of their performance at the institution. While student's performance is assessed during examinations, the performance of the teachers and the staff in terms of the perspective of the students, alumni and parents are assessed through their feedback which is collected online each year. It is essential to create a general awareness among the community about the university functioning and attempts to strengthening its teaching learning activity. In this context it is also pertinent to obtain the feedback from the related community (alumni and parents of the students) about the University. In that process, feedback is collected from all stakeholders namely students, alumni, parents, faculty and administrative staff about their perception about the University functioning. To ensure that the teachers and the staff are provided the working environment conducive to effective performance, their feedback about the University is also collected in a similar manner. In order to strength the University system further and ensure satisfaction of all the stakeholders, it is essential to not only obtain their feedback, but to analyze them carefully and ensure adequate measures to reduce the weaknesses and threats while converting the opportunities into strength. The feedbacks received from the alumni were collated, analyzed and the data were represented graphically (in percentage) as shown below.

The gender based participation in providing the feedback is depicted below as pie charts.

Suggestions for further improvement received from the Alumni are provided below.

- We need a language research centre and Language Lab.
- Incorporation of various necessary and sophisticated instruments such as XRD, TEM etc. will immensely help to boost research and development.
- A website for Alumni with alumni meets conducted in physical/online mode once in a year will benefit the University.
- Recruitment of vacant faculty position at the earliest.
- A new course of M.Phil in Clinical Psychology with adequate practical laboratory facility might be helpful.
- Yearly Convocation is desirable.
- Proper teacher:student ratio as per the UGC rules is needed.
- PG Gents Hostel needs renovation.
- While framing committee, agenda or anything else, Alumni should be inform at least through WhatsApp /telegram group.
- The University administration should recruit faculty for many departments with faculty shortage.
- Open new innovative courses.
- Recruitment laboratory technicians are also required.
- Subscription of IEEE JOURNAL is required
- Further strengthening the campus recruitment will help.
- Bring more opportunity for the students to explore the corresponding field by increasing optional subject.
- Exam pattern and syllabus should be modified so that student can easily crack competitive examinations.
- After I enrolled in another University I came to see the drawbacks of Tripura University. There is scope for improving the regularity of classes, extent of course content covered, teaching quality.
- Communication in local language during teaching should be stopped.
- I will like to suggest that B.Voc department has a future in rubber sector. The course needs to be popularized all over India, especially in rubber sector (private as well as government). For the continuation of this program, new courses like M.Voc in Rubber Technology, M.Sc. in Polymer Science will help. In B.Voc there is LAB where all the equipments belongings to Rubber Technology are available but a technician is required.
- B.Voc Rubber Technology should be changed to B.Sc Rubber Technology.
