




80% teaching staffs (47%: Excellent and 33%: Very good) agree that the vision, philosophy and objectives are specific and clear to them.

Aims and objectives of the syllabi are well defined and clear to teachers and students




84% teaching staffs (50%: Excellent and 34%: Very good) agree that the syllabi are well defined and clear to teachers and students.

#### The course/programme of studies carries sufficient number of optional papers





#### Programs outcomes of the syllabi is well defined




85% teaching staffs (48%: Excellent and 37%: Very good) agree that the programme outcomes of the syllabi are well defined for on-going courses/programme.

#### Curriculum is having good academic flexibility




81% teaching staffs (38%: Excellent and 43%: Very good) agree that the curriculum having good academic flexibility.

#### The course content fulfils the need of students




81% teaching staffs (43%: Excellent and 41%: Very good) agree that the course content fulfils the need of students.

#### Need to fully review the syllabus




69% teaching staffs (19%: Excellent and 31%: Very good, and 19%: Good) agree that agree that there is a need to fully review the syllabus.

#### Students are disciplined and respect the Staff members




97% teaching staffs (56%: Excellent and 37%: Very good) agree that that the students are disciplined and respect the staff members.

#### University provides opportunities for continuous development of Staff




76% teaching staffs (43%: Excellent, 41%: Very good and 17%: Good) agree that the University provides opportunities for continuous development of staff.

#### Equal opportunities for all staff is provided




79% teaching staffs (35%: Excellent, 21%: Very good and 23%: Good) agree there is equal opportunities for all staff is provided.

## University has adequate medical facilities and is equipped to handle medical and other emergencies





## Rest rooms, toilets, laboratory, playground, classrooms are clean and well maintained





#### Clean drinking water is available




78% teaching staffs (22%: Excellent, 28%: Very good and 28%: Good) agree there is an availability of clean drinking water.

## Laboratory requirements including equipment, chemicals and specimens are regularly provided





#### Computer facilities are made available for ICT based teaching to students




87% teaching staffs (34%: Excellent, 32%: Very good and 21%: Good) agree that there is computer facilities available for ICT based teaching to students.

Good facility and encouragement to the teachers for their research




76% teaching staffs (26%: Excellent, 26%: Very good and 24%: Good) agree that there is a good facility and encouragement to the teachers for their research.

## University pays attention to conservation of environment and has taken initiative on implementing waste management practices





#### Officers are approachable and accessible




87% teaching staffs (27%: Excellent, 44%: Very good and 16%: Good) agree that officers are approachable and accessible.

#### **Major Suggestions:**

- Need-based educational orientation is highly required for students and staff. Students are only grade oriented largely.
- There is a dire need for excellent teacher support. For instance, teaching is not only important in higher education; research is equally needed for better performance of the University. However, there is no support for research in social sciences due to the heavy load of teaching. Recruitment should be done regularly.
- Day-care facility should be improved.
- Supporting staff is not well trained or not even eligible for any academic administration in the departments.
- The University must implement more automation in its system starting with student admission,
- File tracking etc. etc. and ending with alumni management and interaction.
- Need for further maintenance/strengthening of infrastructure and more support/ funding for research/ practical.
- e-record keeping must be introduce and digital file / note system must be introduce.
- Computers should be treated as necessary laboratory equipment for computer oriented course curriculum, like Statistics.
- More teaching staff is required to run a professional course such as Journalism and mass Communication. Since 2009, there are three vacant positions in JMC Department, it needs to be filled up immediately.
- C.C.T.V should be improved and Digital attendance system should be for, teachers and non-teaching staff.
