A seminar on "Socio-Political Thought of Kabiguru Rabindranath Tagore" was held on 10th June 2025, from 11:00 AM to 12:00 Noon, at the Conference Room in the Examination Building, Tripura University. It was organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Tripura University. The speaker was Prof. Bidyut Chakraborty, former Vice-Chancellor of Visva-Bharati University. Prof. Shaon Ray Chaudhuri, IQAC Director, along with other faculties and students, were present.

Prof. Chakraborty gave an interesting talk on Tagore's ideas. He said that Tagore was not only a poet, playwright, and novelist, but also a social reformer. He spoke about three essays written by Tagore, which showed how Tagore supported non-violence and self-reliance before they became part of national movements. He said Tagore was inspired by the Upanishads, which he saw as a book of universal truth, not just a religious text. Tagore believed that non-violence was a peaceful way to raise one's voice.

Prof. Chakraborty also said that Tagore's writings showed that history is complex, not just right or wrong. For Tagore, politics meant sharing ideas with everyone, no matter their caste, religion, or background. He also said that Tagore wrote against untouchability before Dr. B.R. Ambedkar became famous for fighting it. In his novel "Gora", Tagore showed how people can change their thoughts and that humanity is more important than any divide. Prof. Chakraborty also talked about Tagore's connection with Tripura, where he visited and wrote about the

“Rajarship”. The seminar gave everyone a better understanding of Tagore’s social and political thoughts.













